ZPass+

How does it work?

Students carry a small card that automatically logs their entry and exit when they pass the scanner on the school bus. The information is then instantly and securely available to parents through the internet. Notifications can also be sent directly to your computer or to your cell phone via text message.

As a participating school district in the OhioSSC Transportation Grant, parents can set up an online account, at no charge, using their child's ZPass card number and immediately access student-specific ridership information on the www.zpassplus.com website.

ZPass is a student ridership tracking and monitoring system that uses a radio frequency identification device (RFID) on the bus and student cards to track the date, time, and location of each student's entry and exit from the bus.



Students scan their ZPass Card when they enter and exit the bus.

The student information with the time, date, and location of the scan is instantly available to the school district through the Ground Traffic Control (GTC) web-based fleet management system. The students' cards contain the child's name and passive RFID information. There is no other personal data stored on the card. As the student enters and exits the bus, they pass the card by a small RFID scanner that

ZPass Facts

What?

ZPass is a student ridership tracking and monitoring system that uses a radio frequency identification device (RFID) and student cards to track the date, time, and location of each student's entry and exit from the bus.

How?

Students carry a card with their name and passive RFID information. As the student enters and exits the bus, they pass the card by a small RFID scanner that beeps as the card is read. The identification information with the time, date, and location of the scan is instantly available to the school district through the Ground Traffic Control web-based fleet management system.

Why?

Child safety is of primary concern to schools and parents. ZPass helps ensure the safe transportation of children to and from school and school-related events. If a child is missing, the school district can accurately determine if, when, and where the child entered or left the bus.

When?

ZPass will be implemented in the 2015-2016 School Year
